

Fast4 Tennis Rules

What is Fast4 Format, here is a breakdown:

Scoring: Scoring will remain the same: 15, 30, 40, game.

First to 4 games wins the set.

Players will play 2 Fast4 sets and then Fast4 5-point super-tiebreaker if they split sets.

The Fast4 super-tiebreaker is same format as the 5-point tiebreaker (see below), except the winner of the tiebreaker wins the match.

Normally in a Fast4 format you would play lets, but we will not be playing lets. Sever will replay all let serves as we normally would do.

Fast4 uses No-Ad scoring. At Deuce, the receiver chooses which side the server serves to. It is the receiver's responsibility to let the server know which side they want to receive serve on. So, if the receiver attempts to play the point then the point stands as played.

The Fast4 5-Point Tiebreaker: When games reach 3 all in the set then the players will play a Fast4 5-point tiebreaker.

The first to 5 points, win by 1

Each player serves 2 points then change sides after 4 points.

If a tiebreaker reaches 4-4, next point wins. Players come to net and spin to determine who will serve or who will receive. The winner of the spin has 2 options: 1) They can serve or 2) They can receive. The receiver has choice to which court the server will serve to.

ALL OTHER USTA RULES REMAIN UNCHANGED AND SHALL BE FOLLOWED BY ALL PLAYERS

PLAYERS WILL BE PERMITTED A MAXIMUM OF 10 MINUTES TO WARMUP, INCLUDING ANY SERVES.
